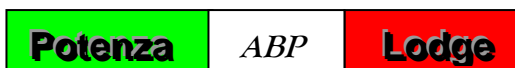

April 10th 6:30 p.m. Easter Dinner, Regular Business Meeting, Ham Dinner; ladies please bring a side dish to feed 10 people.

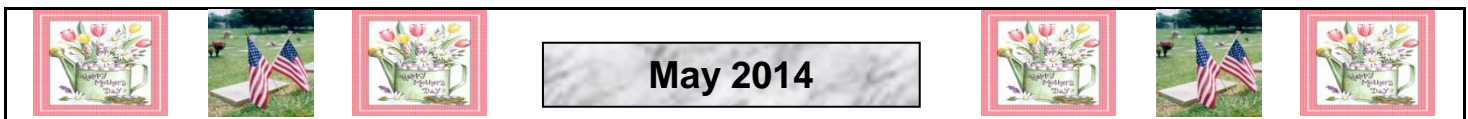
